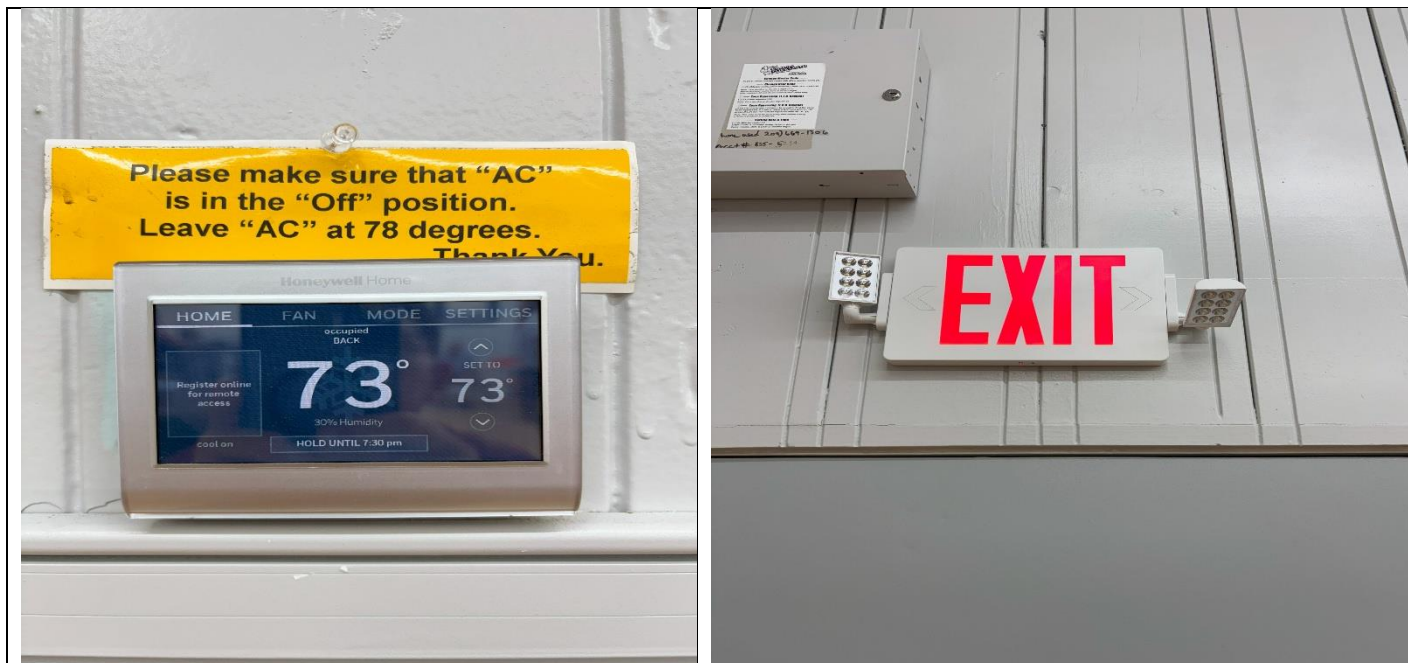

### **An Editorial – The Way, We See It – Richard Fantazia**

“THE HOUSE THAT RUTH BUILT” If you are a sports fan, especially a baseball fan, you probably know about Babe Ruth, the Bambino. He is regarded as one of the greatest baseball players of all time. He played in 22 seasons from 1914 to 1935, hitting 714 home runs in his career, a record that stood for decades.

You might ask how a baseball player builds a house? Was he an Architect? Was he a street worker? Was he a carpenter? No, none of these. What he was a prolific home run hitter with a charismatic persona that captivated fans and brought them in by the droves. The demand to accommodate the increased fans that wanted to see The Babe play ended up with the number of expansions and modifications to Yankee Stadium. These expansions and modifications would not have occurred until years later, thus the moniker of “The House That Ruth Built.”

We too of Fr. Heslin Council have built a house if you really think about it. It all started in the early 80’s when Manny Serpa spearheaded the officers and leaders of the time, to buy acreage off Lander Avenue to eventually build a hall for our events and meetings. In the 90’s, an adjoining business wanted to expand and made a proposal to buy the land from which our council was able to purchase the old Jehovah Witness Hall on South Broadway (a building that needed a lot of work.)

In 2015, the Turlock Gospel Mission came to us wanting to purchase our building for offices. They had no money, but the City of Turlock intervened in their behalf and paid us. The main part of the deal was that the city would have to find us a building for us to relocate or we would rescind the sale. A run-down building on East Ave. that was formerly used by the homeless and before that The Youth Center Building was settled on and the property was transferred from the city to us. The

Hall is mortgage free and is being maintained and improvements made from rental moneys from the foresight of food trucks being located in our parking lot.

So...we built a house, if you will, not physical but by bargaining and maneuvering so that our council can continue to provide for our youth, church, school, and community.

Thank you, Manny Serpa and company, for starting up the building of our house and thanks to us in this time frame for improving the house for future knights to come after us.

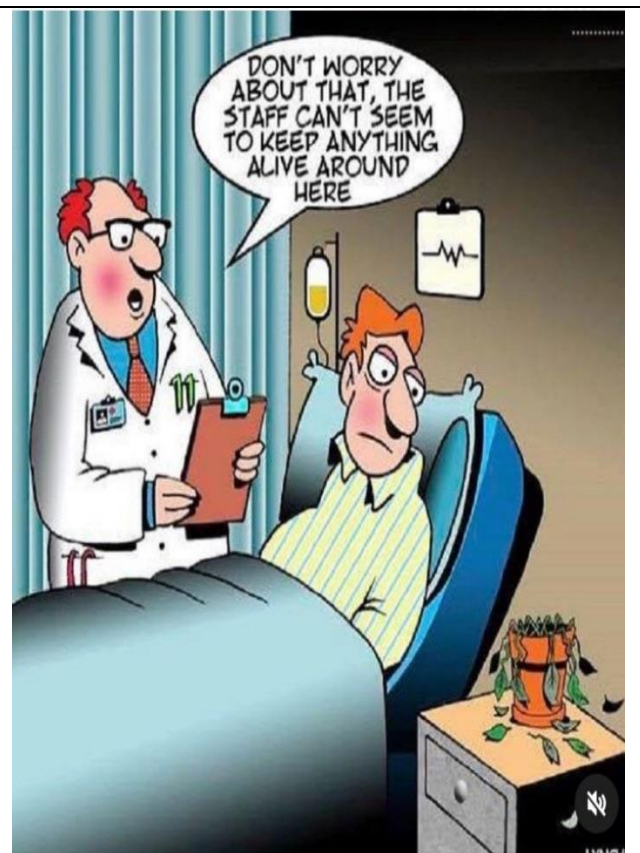

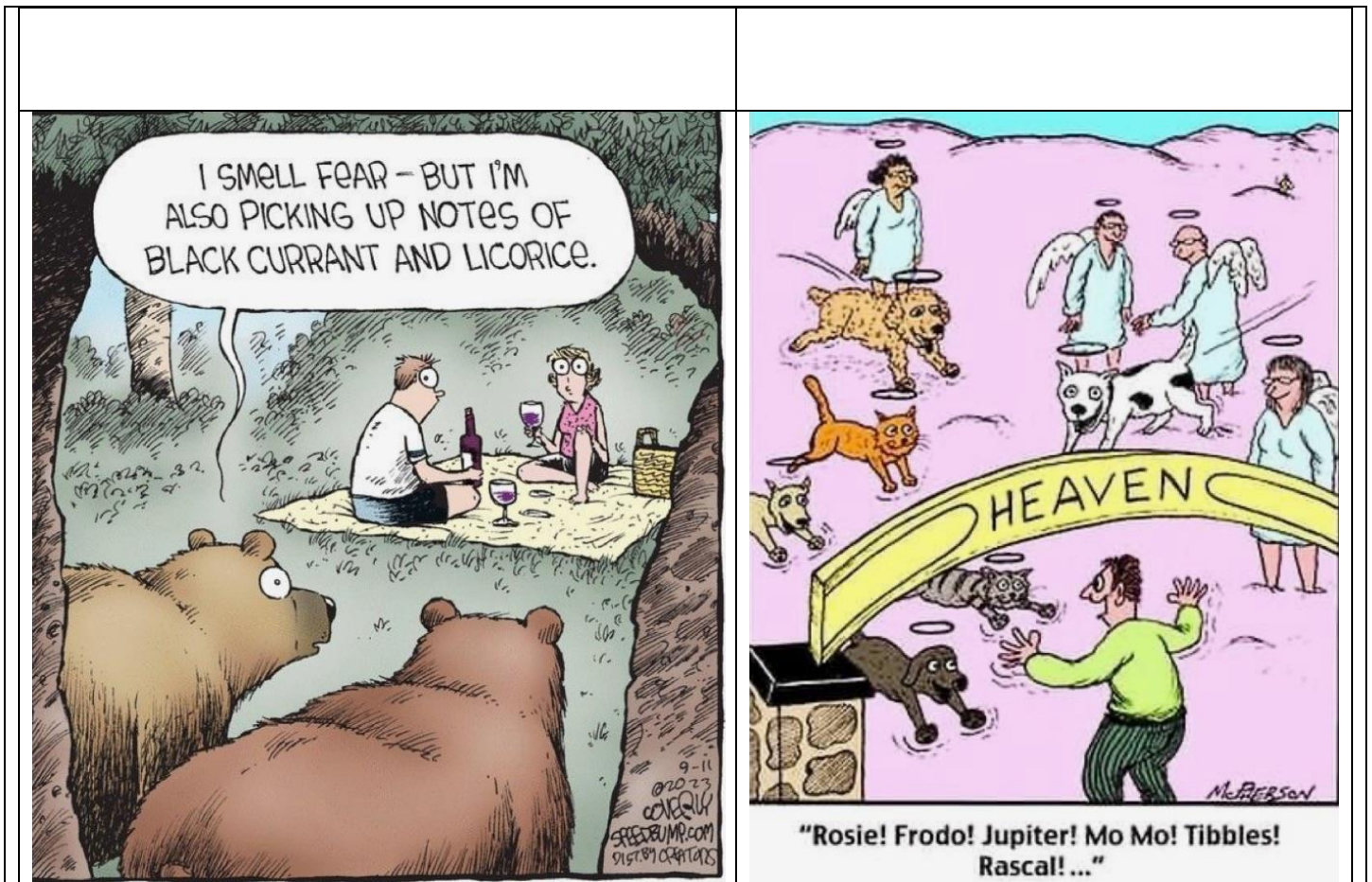
