Accessing and Restoring a Previous Page Revision

1. Navigate to your specific page and click "Edit" to open it in the editor.
2. The page will load in the default Block Editor view (see Image #1).








On the "Revisions" page (see Image #3):

Item 2 shows the HTML code of the previous version of your content—this is the version before your most recent changes.

Item 3 shows the HTML code of the current version, reflecting your latest edits.

Item 1 is the slider you can use to scroll through and view older saved revisions.

Select the version you'd like to restore. Click the "Restore This Revision" button, located at the top-right corner of the screen (see **Image #4** for reference).

You also have the option to compare any two revisions. Once your comparison is complete, simply click "**Restore This Revision**" to revert to that version.
